





Important Information Before Your Visit

Feel Comfortable Coming Back

We're working hard to make sure your return to the POPS is enjoyable and safe. Here are some of the ways we and our venue are working to help you feel comfortable coming back:

	<p>Proof of Vaccine Requirement</p> <p>All guests 12 years of age or older for all public events will be required to show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination for entry into all Kimmel Cultural Campus venues. Adults 18+ will be required to show photo identification with their vaccination proof.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• “Fully Vaccinated” means that a guest’s event is at least 14 days after their final COVID-19 vaccine dose.• Valid proof of vaccination includes the following: vaccination card, photo or digital copy of proof of vaccination.• Proof of a negative COVID test will not be accepted, except for children under the age of 12.• Children under 12 will be required to show a negative test result of a PCR test taken within 72 hours of the event.
	<p>Mask Enforcement</p> <p>All patrons are required to wear masks inside the venue at all times (except when consuming food or beverage). Prolonged periods of mask removal are not permitted.</p>
	<p>Healthy Ventilation Initiative</p> <p>The Kimmel Cultural Campus has already completed numerous COVID-19 countermeasures across their Campus, including significant investments to HVAC systems to meet CDC recommendations, maximizing fresh air intake per hour, and using recommended Merv-13 air filters to optimize air quality.</p>
	<p>Increased Cleaning & Sanitation Procedures</p> <p>The Kimmel Cultural Campus is increasing frequency and thoroughness of disinfection of high-touch areas with CDC-recommended products; and has equipped each of their venues with numerous hand sanitizer dispensers.</p>

The Kimmel Cultural Campus will continue with their scenario planning in the event that restrictions change again, and we will continue to coordinate and share that information with you and your group.
